Onikooko Primary School: Current State

- Location:
 - The primary school is located in Onikooko village which is a rural AFIJIO community.
- Student Population:
 - There are approximately 400 students at the school from 1st to 6th grade.
- Condition:
 - Deplorable and dilapidated classroom blocks, most with collapsed walls and roofs.
 - At least 50% of the students receive instructions outside in the open, and under trees.
 - No safe drinking water, and no sanitary toilet facilities.

Project Objectives

- To lift up the children of the Onikooko village by providing a reasonable and sanitary learning environment which includes:
 - a new water well; and
 - a new building block with two classroom units.

Objective: New Water Well

- This objective was initiated in partnership with Wells4Africa and the IITA Students.
- It was successfully completed and commissioned in March 2008!

Objective: New Building Block

- This project is on hold until additional sponsorship can be found.
- Total cost of project with contingency is about \$13,000
- Total funds currently available to the AOOOF foundation is about \$6,000.
- We need to raise \$5,000 - \$7,000 to initiate the project.

Project Costing

● Foundation & Flooring:	\$1800	
● Wall Framing:	\$4,500	
● Roofing:	\$2,600	
● Doors & Windows:	\$1,500	
● Electrical:	\$500	
● Painting:	\$500	
● Keys & Locks:	\$100	
– Total Costs:		\$11,500
● Contingency (20%):	\$2,300	
● Grand Total:		\$13,800
